We urge everyone to attend the genealogy session this year. Here are the plans.

1. **1940 U.S. Census Indexing** –encourage our family to sign up to help with that. This census is so important. We have only 6 months to index it and everyone's help is needed.

2. **FamilySearch FamilyTree** --The full version should be released by the end of the year 2012 (or end of September). Things that are now "LIVE" in FamilyTree are: Sources & documentation. We will show the acceptable pattern & handout a copy as an example. These will not show up in the nFS but will show up when the final release is out. We will stress the importance of documentation. We will go through **FamilyTree** and explain where things are located and how they are arranged. When the final release is out we will be able to submit images, however, they will be as links through URLs.

3. **We will have pictures of Jacob Benson Cazier** and the Mount Vernon Place Plantation and where White Hall is where he was born

4. Answer questions about where we are and where we should be in regard to our genealogy.

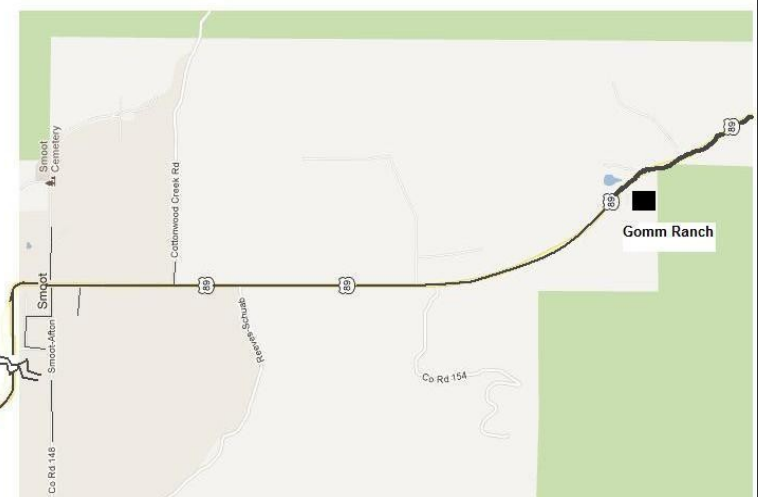
